- 3. **Method of Entry** All entries must be made in writing and must be sent to the Secretary: Anna Stable, Bolton Manor Farm, Little Urswick, Ulverston, Cumbria, LA12 OPX or northerndairyexpo@gmail.com
- **4. Presentation of Cattle –** Cattle may be washed and clipped for judging.

Animals must be pre-sorted ready for the judge's inspection Animals should be presented on hard standing for the judge's inspection

Animals may **NOT** be presented on a halter.

- **5. Substitutes** Will be permitted, details of substitute must be given to the steward on inspection by judge.
- **6. Classes** The Committee reserves the right to amalgamate or split classes depending on the number of entries. **Each animal is only eligible for ONE class.**
- **7.** Class Winners All 1st & 2nd prize winners will be considered for Championship competitions
- **8. Exhibitor Bred** For the purpose of the competition any animals born on the exhibitors farm and carrying his or her own prefix will be deemed to be exhibitor bred.
- **9. Disputes** The Northern Dairy on Farm Expo Committee in relation to all matters concerning this show is final. All disputes are to be logged in writing on the evening of the presentations with a fee of £50.
- **10. Vet Fees** Any feed incurred for the animals which are treated by a vet whilst competing in the competition must be settled by the exhibitor.
- **11. TB Status** As the competition is being judged on farm and there is no movement of cattle any farm is able to enter, even if under TB restrictions.
